- Squirt into a tray get feet and hands stuck in! Make patterns, do some writing, drawing, pat it and clap it together!
- 2. Add shaving foam to sand for a unique sensory experience
- 3. Add ice cubes to shaving foam to explore the different textures

4. Slip and slide toy cars in the foam or use it as a building material for foam bricks to stick together!

5. Create rainbow foam by putting blobs of different coloured paints in ready for the children

to spread and mix!
